



Homestay and High School in Ireland

SCHOOL EXPERIENCE

Within this program, students are completely immersed in the English language and do not have opportunities to speak their own mother tongue: this allows a quick improvement of the language skills. Students get the unique opportunity to discover a new way of life and a new culture first hand, not like a tourist! The homestay program is the most affordable language travel!

This program is ideally suited to mature and independent students, eager to meet new people from abroad and with enough language proficiency to communicate with host family members. The pure homestay program is a true cultural exchange.

We place our international students for short term homestay and school integration program in County Kerry, Limerick, Tipperary and Cork. All schools require uniforms. A typical school day begins at 9am and ends around 3.45pm. Extracurricular activities vary from school to school but usually sports activities are provided. Students may also join local clubs for sports and activities e.a Football/Soccer, Basketball, Dance and Music. Students are hosted by local families, warm and welcoming.

SCHOOL SYSTEM

International students go to school with their host siblings or children of the neighborhood. They attend regular classes with their classmates and participate in all school activities. This is a cultural program, not an academic program. Students should not expect to receive any grade transcript.

Secondary education is generally completed at a community school, a comprehensive school, a vocational school or a voluntary secondary school. A typical secondary school will consist of 1st to 3rd year, the optional Transition Year (age under 16), the 5th year (age 16/17) and 6th year (age 17 and over). Courses offered generally Art, Biology, Business, Chemistry, Physics, English, Economics, French, German, Geography, History, Home Economics, Mathematics, Music, Religion, Computer and P.E.. Some schools offer extra English classes.

The school year runs from late August/early September to late May.
