The program runs from July to August 2025, with flexible arrival and departure dates and a minimum stay of 2 weeks.

Students stay in private studio apartments equipped with a bathroom, air conditioning, and essential furnishings, located close to campus for convenience and access to public transit.

Terms and Dates

• Arrival Days: Every Sunday, from June 22 to August 10, 2025.

- Departure Days: Every Saturday, from July 5 to August 23, 2025.
- Minimum Stay: Students are required to enroll for at least 2 weeks to ensure a full immersion experience.
- Optional Activities: Students have the option to join weekend trips for an additional fee, such as:
 - Busan Trip: A journey to Korea's coastal city with stops at Haeundae Beach, Jagalchi Fish Market, and the scenic Yonggungsa Temple.
 - Je ju Island Tour: A nature-focused weekend on Je ju Island, including visits to Seongsan Ilchulbong Peak, Hamdeok Beach, and the island's volcanic landscapes.
